at the Inter-Ministerial level. Steps have aslo been taken to transfer additional power from other grids to the DVC to the extent possible. Also a variety of measures which inter alia. include renovation and modernisation of the existing units and adding to the existing capacity through short gestation schemes have been undertaken.

As a long term measure and to reduce the dependence of steel plants on external power supply, additional captive generation capacities are being created by setting up a (3x60 MW) captive power plant at Bokaro Steel Plant and a (2x60 MW) captive power plant at Durgapur Steel Plant.

## Lift irrigation scheme in Andhra Pradesh

3289. PROF. C. LAKSHMANNA: SHRI PUTTAPAGA RADHA-KRISHNA:

Will the Minister of WATER RE-SOURCES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is any Lift Irrigation Scheme of the Central Government to be implemented on river Krishna at Chinna Marrur village, Veepangandla Mandal - in Mahabub Nagar district of Andhra Pradesh with the aid of the Government of Netherlands: and
- (b) if so, what is the present stage of the scheme?

THE MINISTER OF WATER RE-SOURCES (SHRI B. SHANKARA-NAND): (a) and (b) There is no such scheme of Government of India. However, the Government of Andhra Pradesh has proposed certain Subsurface and Surface Water Minor Irrigation Schemes for Netherlands assistance which include Lift Irrigation Schemes on river Krishna addition to four other river basins. Five districts, namely, Guntur, Kurnool, Mahabub Negar, Nalgonda and Krishna are proposed to be covered in the Krishna River Basin. exact locations of the Schemes are yet to be finalised. The Planning Commission have sought certain clarifications to clear the proposal and these are awaited from the Government of Andhra Pradesh.
