

(c) if so, what are the details in this regard and the total number of Pakistani spies arrested and what action has been taken against them; and

(d) whether any guidelines have been issued to the State Authorities to keep a vigil and deal with the foreign spies and if so, what are the details in regard thereto?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI P. CHIDAMBARAM): (a) According to information furnished by the Delhi Administration, one Pak national was arrested on 8-9-86 and a case under section 319 of the Official Secrets Act was registered against him on the same day at Police Station, Naraina.

(b) and (c) According to information available, 25 Pak spies were arrested in August and September, 1986. The number of persons arrested State-wise is as under:

All the cases are investigated by the law enforcing agencies of the State Governments/UT Administration concerned.

(d) Government is seized of the problem of espionage, particularly in the border States, and vigilance by the security agencies on the Indo-Pakistan border and other vulnerable areas has been intensified to check espionage activities.

Facilities for training of pilots

(b) if so, what are the broad details of the measures being taken in India to set up the latest facilities and equipment for the training of Indian fighter pilots?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENCE PRODUCTION AND SUPPLIES IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI SHIVRAJ PATIL): (a) Yes, Sir.
