Establishment of a Computer Centre in Orissa

344. SHRI SUBAS MOHANTY: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal under Government's consideration to establish a computer centre in Orissa;

(b) if so, when and at which place; and

(c) what are the financial implications of the proposal?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF OCEAN DEVELOPMENT, ATOMIC ENERGY, ELECTRONICS AND SPACE (SHRI K. R. NARAYANAN): Yes, Sir, there is a proposal to establish computer centres in Orissa.

(b) The National Informatics Centre (NIC) has already established its regional centre at Bhubaneswar where

a super computer is being installed. Also NIC plans to instal micro-computer systems at each of the districts in Orissa and this will be connected to the NIC Computer Network (NIC-NET). The country-wide network is expected to be established by NIC by the end of 1987.

(c) Government has already invested about Rs. 6 crores at the NIC Regional Centre at Bhubaneswar and each district system and its installation is expected to cost about Rs. 1.5-2 lakhs.

Computerisation of Ordnance Depots

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENCE PRODUCTION AND SUPPLIES IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI SHIVRAJ PATIL): (a) to (c) It is proposed to computerise the Ordnance Depots in a phased manner.
