

Evaluation of the 5-day Week Scheme

223. DR. MOHD. HASHIM KID-WAI: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to refer to answer to the reply to Unstarred Question 307 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 25th July, 1986 and state:

(a) whether Government have made any assessment or evaluation of the 5-day Week Scheme introduced in the Ministries/Departments of the Government of India;

(b) if so, what are the details regarding attendance of officers and employees; and

(c) what is the extent to which the efficiency in the Ministries/Departments has increased by introduction of the 55-day Week Scheme?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS (SHRI BIREN SINGH ENGTI): (a) No formal comprehensive assessment or evaluation has been made.

(b) and (c) These details will be available only when such a full-fledged study is made.

Crack in the South-End Shield of RAPS

(a) when the crack in the South-End shield of Rajasthan Atomic Power Station was detected; and

(b) by when Government propose to arrive at a decision on the various alternatives open to the Department of Atomic Energy in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF OCEAN DEVELOPMENT, ATOMIC ENERGY, ELECTRONICS AND SPACE (SHRI K. R. NARAYANAN): (a) Leakage of

light water from South End Shield of RAPS Unit-I was first detected in Sep-temper 1981.

(b) Detailed examination of alternative courses of action is in progress and a decision on the preferred alternative is expected shortly.
