

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COOPERATION IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) and (b) Statewise details of extent of damage caused to life and property due to floods, heavy rains etc. during the monsoon period of 1986 are given in Annexure-I. (c) State-wise details of Central assistance sought by the affected States/ U. T. s are given in the enclosed Statement. (See below)

(d) A ceiling of expenditure of Rs. 26. 67 Crores has been approved for flood relief for Kerala so far out of the States indicated in the Annexure referred to in part (a) above. Flood prevention and control is a State subject. The planning and execution of various flood protection works is done by the State Governments.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COOPERATION IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) The Central Team found that a cropped area of 50, 279 ha. in 563 villages of 7 districts were affected by floods.

(b) and (c) Based on the report of the Central Team and recommendations of the High Level Committee on Relief, a ceilings of expenditure amounting to Rs. 18. 08 crores has been approved for flood relief in Punjab.
