435. SHRI SATYA PAL MALIK: Will the Minister of

URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to refer to the reply to Unstarred Question 1583 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 8th August, 1986 and state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government quarters (old type) at Minto Road, New Delhi in spite of being very old and earmarked for demolition are still being allowed to be under occupation of bonafide government servants along with the people of Delhi Development Authority (J. J. Wing) in spite of the risk involved in it and besides insanitary conditions are created as a result thereof in the area;
