Pachartal to Agartala rail line

*134. SHRI NARAYAN KAR: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) what are the details of the survey report for construction of railway line from Pachartal to Agartala;

(b) whether Government have any proposal to include the scheme for construction of said railway line in the Seventh Five Year Plan; and

(c) if not, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MADHAVRAO SCINDIA): (a) Construction of Metre Gauge railway line from Dharmanagar to Kumar-ghat is an approved on-going work.

Updating of Preliminary Engineer-ing-cum-Traffic Survey for further extension of the line from Kumar-ghat to Agartala has been done. Estimated cost of construction of the 130 kms. long line is Rs- 283 crores.
