

(b) The Zonal Railways give certain facilities to those customers who give regular and sizeable traffic to the Railways. Such parties can make a lumpsum deposit towards wagon registration fee and regular supply of wagons to them is arranged, as far as practicable.

Setting up of a university in Tripura

897. SHRI NARAYAN KAR: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to set up a University in Tripura during the Seventh Five Year Plan period; and

(b) if so, what are the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI P. V. NARASIMHA RAO): (a) and (b) The Central Government has no such proposal under consideration. However, the Government of Tripura is considering a proposal to establish a University in that State.

New facilities for training Hockey players

898. SHRIMATI RENUKA CHOWDHURY: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether in view of the performance of Indian Hockey team in International games at Seoul and London, Government propose to assist the Indian Hockey Federation to introduce new facilities in training the hockey players and also for grooming new players; and

(b) if so, what steps are being taken in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS AND WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOP-

MENT IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI MARGARET ALVA): (a) and (b) Government have been providing financial and technical facilities for the coaching of Indian Hockey teams selected by the Indian Hockey Federation, prior to its participation in International Tournaments. The facilities provided include meeting expenditure on the running of coaching camps, provision of the diet money during the coaching camps, making available for the camps trained coaches wherever required by the federation and holding of coaching camps at the senior, junior, and sub-junior levels. Exposure to international competition is also encouraged by meeting air-passage cost both ways in respect of the players of the national teams going for participation in international tournaments abroad. Similarly, assistance is also made available for holding of international tournaments in the country. While the Government will continue to do so in future also, it has also introduced a new scheme of laying synthetic tracks and artificial surfaces in various parts of the country.

Review of projects for child welfare

(a) whether Government have made any review of the ongoing projects for child welfare in the country;

(b) if so, what are the results thereof;

(c) what is the quantum of Central assistance given to States for implementation of the scheme during the current year i.e. 1986-87; and

(d) whether the quantum of central assistance (is likely to be increased in the next year?
