

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI SANTOSH MOHAN BEV); (a) Yes, Sir. However, the agitation was called off on 8.11.1986.

(b) (1) Revision of pay scale of Junior Engineer from scale of 1400—2300 to Rs. 1640—2900 and Selection Grade scale to Rs. 2000—3200.

(2) Change in the promotion rules to Assistant Engineers to allow for promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness rather than by the selection;

(3) Question of pay fixation under FR 22(C) for JEs promoted from the cadre of Selection Grade Phone Inspectors, Transmission Assistants etc.

(c) Yes, Sir.

(d) The extent of loss of direct revenue is approximate Rs. 50 lakhs per day and indirect loss cannot be readily estimated.

(e) The Government have appointed a High Power Committee to examine the demand of revision of pay scales of JEs. The question of amendment to Recruitment Rules 1981 is being expedited and the issue of restoration of FR 22(C) for fixation of pay of Junior Engineers promoted through Selection Grade Phone Inspectors, etc. and the deduction of pay because of refixation of pay under FR 22(a) is being taken up at a very high level for early and favourable settlement.

Barbed wire fencing on Indo-Bangladesh border

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI CHINTAMANI PANIGRAH): (a) and (b) It has been decided first to take up the construction of border roads etc., along the Indo-Bangladesh border. Survey work for border roads in some areas is already in progress. The question of border fence will be taken up after construction of roads. Efforts will be made to complete the work as early as possible.
