

### Opening of a Passport Office at Gangtok

1416. SHRI LEONARD SOLOMAN SARING : Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that a large number of Passport applications are lying pending at the Regional Passport Office, Calcutta since two to three years from the State of Sikkim;

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor;

(c) whether there is any proposal under Government's consideration to open a

Passport office at Gangtok Sikkim as prior to 1975; and

(d) if so, what are the details in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI EDUARDO FALEIRO) : (a) No, Sir.

The number of applications received, passports issued and pendency since 1984 has been as under :
