Expansion and repairing of railway stations

- *231. SHRI NARESH C. PUGLIA; Will the Minister of RAILWAY be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government have a plan under their consideration to expand and repair some of the railway stations region-wise in the near future:
- (b) if so, what are the names of stations included for the purpose in Maharashtra, during 1986-87 and 1987-88;
- (c) what are the broad outlines of this plan and the time by when it is likely to be implemented; and
- (d) what are the budget estimates provided for repairing and expansion in Maharashtra?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MADHAVRAO SCINDIA): (a) The Railways are undertaking expansion and repairs of Railway stations depending on the traffic needs and condition of the building. There is also a scheme to •develop model stations on a planned basis.

- (b) Names of model stations in Maharashtra State are Akola, Bombay VT Pune, Nagpur, Sholapur, Nanded, Gondia and Bombay Central.
- (c) The works are being taken up on -a. programmed basis depending on the traffic requirements, condition of buildings end availability of funds.
- (d) Separate funds are not earmarked for such works. The funds allotted for the year 1986-87 under passenger amenities for the zonal Railways serving Maharashtra are given below:

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI JAGDISH TYTLER): (a) There is no such proposal under consideration at present.

(b) and '(c) Helicopters being acquired by the Helicopter Corporation of India wil] primarily cater to the transportation needs of the Oil Sector. Helicopters atet being offered to State Governments/ Union Territories, on wet-lease in the first instance, with high priority to the North-East, so the stations to be airlinked and the pattern of operations etc. will be" decided by the State Governments/Union Territories.
