(a) whether Government are aware that the new book 'Urdu Ki Kitab' brought out by NCERT under the new education policy for Class XI completely omits the names of some of the great writers in Urdu and instead the names of minor Pakistani poets have been included; and

(b) if so, what steps have been taken by Government to withdraw the book containing gross inaccuracies from the school course and also from the market besides making an inquiry into the circumstances under which the book was approved for publication?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI P. V. NARASIMHA RAO): (a) 'Urdu Ki Nai Kitab', a textbook for Class XI for students whose mother tongue is Urdu, is one of a series of textbooks commissioned by the NCERT four years ago. It has been prepared by three scholars of Jamia Millia Islamia under the supervision of a high level committee of Urdu scholars. It is not true that minor Urdu poets of Pakistan have been included.
