

(a) to (d) The development of vaccines for birth control is under process at the National Institute of Immunology. The National Institute of Immunology has taken action to patent one of the vaccines and the other is under process. Approval of WHO is not required for such cases.

Birth rate

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (KUMARI SAROJ KHAPARDE): (a) to (c) Birth Rate estimated as obtained from the Sample Registration System of Registrar General, India are available on calendar year basis. According to Registrar General, India the latest information on Birth Rate is available for the year, 1984 and the same is 33.9 per thousand population at the national level.
