Rajasthan and Punjab. In Tamil Nadu, it been n confirmed that the deaths took has place due to Gastroenteritis. In respect oj two incidents that took place in Maharashtra, one was in the Cam a Hospital wherein a mix up of drugs caused the death. In respect of the other deaths were caused due to abesess following vaccination with unsteri-llaKd syringes and needles. In Raj-asthan, one child was under treatment for about 20 days prior to date of vaccination died after the vaccination. In Gujarat, one child died with the administration of con. taminated measles vaccine at the hands of health worker. The three incidents that took place in U. P., Punjab and Haryana revealed that children after immunization developed symptoms severe vomitting and diarrhoea. These reactions are not generally associated as a reaction or complications following vaccination. The State Governments would be taking appropriate action against those responsible for these incidents, after getting the final reports of ento avoid incidence of quiry. As a measure health staff and parasuch mishaps the medical workers are continuously trained. Both financial and material assistance a?e also provided to the State* for maintaining the cold-chain etc. for preserving the vaccines at the appropriate temperatures. StaV5 been requested to maintain flose supervision of the Immunization Programme.
