

(b) if so, what are the details of the complaints received from the 'H' Block residents in this regard during the last six months; and

(c) what steps C. P. W. D. authorities have taken to replace the same till date and reasons for not replacing the W. C. pots since long?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI DALBIR SINGH): (a) It is a fact that a few W. C. pots in the flats located in Kali Bari Marg, New Delhi particularly in 'H' Block, type 'B' quarters were broken. It is, however, not a fact that CPWD is neglecting to replace them.

(b) The number of complaints received in this regard during the last six months is 8.

(c) Five W. C. pots have already been replaced and two numbers repaired. One is under replacement.

Drillers in Geological Survey of India

2370. SHRI CHOWDHARY RAM SEWAK: Will the Minister of STEEL AND MINES be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Drillers in Geological Survey of India are stagnating in their posts for the last 20-25 years;

(b) if so, whether Government propose to remove the stagnation of the Drillers, by promoting them as D.E. (Jr.); and

(c) if so, by when a decision is likely to be taken?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRIMATI RAM DULARI SINHA):

(a) to (c) Some of the Drillers are stagnating in their posts for 10 years or more. In order to remove this stagnation,

the Government have a proposal for promoting them as Drilling Engineer (Jr.) and for that purpose provision is being made for 70 additional Group 'A' posts in Drilling Stream of G. S. I. in the spread over of the 5 years of the VIII Five Year Plan. As soon as these posts are created and filled up, the stagnation will be removed.

Representation of Drilling Officers Association

2371. SHRI CHOWDHARY RAM SEWAK: Will the Minister of STEEL AND MINES be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have received a representation dated the 28th July, 1986 from the Secretary-General, Drilling Officers Association, Geological Survey of India; and

(b) if so, what action has been or proposed to be taken?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRIMATI RAM DULARI SINHA):

(a) Yes, Sir.

(b) At present there is no post of Drilling Engineer (Jr.) lying vacant. Government have provided for 70 additional posts of Group 'A' in the Drilling stream of G. S. I., in the spread over of 5 years of the VII Five Year Plan. As soon as these posts are created and filled up, the grievances of the Association will be mitigated.

Surplus Bauxite/Alumina with BALCO

2373. SHRI PARVATHANENI UPENDRA: Will the Minister of STEEL AND MINES be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Bauxite/Alumina which is needed for the Korba Plant of Bharat Aluminium Company is available from the National Aluminium Company mines which are currently under development; and

(b) whether it is also a fact that NALCO has a surplus of Bauxite with no export orders?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRIMATI RAM DULARI SINHA):
(a) No, Sir.

(b) National Aluminium Company Limited's (NALCO) bauxite mine at Panchpatmali has been developed for a production of 2.4 million tonnes of bauxite annually to match the requirements of its Alumina Plant at Damanjodi. NALCO has no surplus bauxite at present. There is also no proposal to export bauxite from NALCO.

Increase in Agricultural Production and Land Deterioration due to Tawa, Gandak and Kosi Projects in Madhya Pradesh, Bihar and Orissa

2374. SHRI ATAL BIHARI VAJPAYEE:

SHRI KAILASH PATI MISHRA:

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

(a) the estimated increase in agricultural production and also land deterioration due to the Tawa Project in Madhya Pradesh, Gandak and Kosi Projects in Bihar and Mahanadi Project in Orissa during the last three years; and

(b) what has been the investment in each project?

THE MINISTER OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND): (a) The estimated increase in yields per ha. in respect of wheat is 0.2 tonne and 0.4 tonne in Gandak and Tawa projects respectively. The increase in yields per ha. in respect of paddy is 0.81 tonne and 1.25 tonnes in Gandak and Mahanadi projects respectively. The yield in respect of cereals was 2.04 tonnes per ha. in Kosi project during 1985-86. The
