THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M. ARUNACHALAM): (a) Target of production of cement during the year 1985-86 was 33.50 million tonnes.

(b) and (c) Production of cement during 1985-86 was about 33.1 million tonnes achieving about 99 per cent of the target. The marginal shortfall in production compared to the target during 1985-86 was mainly due to the heavy and prolonged power-cuts in some of the major cement producing States particularly Karnataka and Rajasthan, labour problems in some plants, shortage of coal and wagons in certain cases and delay in the commissioning schedule of some of the new projects.

(d) With a view to increase the cement production, efforts are continuously made to encourage maximum utilisation of existing capacity, by removing the infrastructural constraints inhibiting production. The progress of new schemes which have been sanctioned is also periodically reviewed to ensure commissioning of the projects as per schedule.

Cess from beedi industry

1985-86	Rs. 40.30 lakhs for Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu.
