Borgarh-Raipur line

(b) whether the above proposal is expected to be implemented during the current financial year?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MADHAVRAO SCINDIA): (a) and (b) Survey for augmentation of line capacity for Champa-Drug-Iharsuguda section has been approved. Various alternatives including survey for a new line would be studied. Further action will be considered after the survey is completed.

Railway workshop at Gondal

(a) what is the turn-over of Gondal workshop of the Western Railway during the last three years, year-wise;

(b) whether it is a fact that the workers in the works shop remain idle for want of regular coach repair work;

(c) if so, what steps Government propose to take in this regard;

(d) whether Government propose to close down the workshop, if so, what are the reasons therefor;

(e) whether some cash incentive schemes have been introduced in Junagadh and Bhavnagar workshops, if so, what are the details thereof; and

(f) whether Gondal workshop is more economical than Bhavnagar and Junagadh workshops?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MADHAVRAO SCINDIA): (a) Gondal workshop of Western Railway undertakes Periodical overhaul (POH)/nominated repairs (NPOH) of coaching stock other than coaches built by Integral Coach Factory. The outturn of the workshop in terms of average monthly outturn during the last three years, was as follows:—
