(a) whether any land ha^j been acquired . for the Pondicherry University, and

(b) if so, what are the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE (SHRIMATI SUSHILA ROHATGI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The land for the establishment of the Pondicherry University is to be provided by ihe Pondicherry Administration. According to information available 411 acres of land has so far been acquired and hand, ed over to the University.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS Op EDUCATION AND CULTURE (SHRIM.-VTI SUSHILA ROHATGI): (a) to (c) The benefit of ad-hcc.bonus sanctioned io th[^] Central Government employees has been extended to teachers drawing thg UGC scales of pay in thg Central Universities and other institutions whose maintenance expenditure is met by the Central Government, effective from the accounting year 1984-85. There is no proposal under the Central Govern-

ment's consideration to e[^]nd this benefit to teachars In the universities and colleges whose maintenance etpenditure is met by the Slate Governments.

According to the Information furnished by the Delhi Univer- sity, there are no 'sick' Colleges in D^eihi. However, the Rao Tula Ram College hud stopped admission from 1980-81 and has become defunct. The students and staff of this college were absorbed in other colleges of the University.

(d) No such proposal is under Govern- ment's consideration.
