(d) if so, what are the names of the vaccines and sera which are being released without test and the reasons for not testing before release

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI S. KRISHNA KUMAR): (a) Information is given in the enclosed statement (See below).

(b) No, Sir.

(c) and (d) Most of the vaccines are released only after testing. Under exceptional circumstances such as epidemics, vaccines are released without testing. Measles Mumps and Rubella (MMR) vaccine for which testing facilities have not been developed indigenously, is released based on certificate issued by Health authorities of the exporting country alongwith full protocols of the test and batch release.
