Voluntary disclosure ot concealed income

639. SHRI RAOOF VALIULLAH: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to refer to the answer to Unstarred Ojiestion No. 120 given tn the Rajya Sabha on the 25th February, 1986 and state:

- (a) Wnether it is a fact that there was lack of positive response to the Scheme of voluntary disclosure of concealed income due to ambiguity prevailing in the Income-Tax Department; and
- (b) whether the Scheme has been extended beyond 31st March, 1986, and if so, what are the reasons there-for ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI JANARDHAN POOJARI): (a) No, Sir.

(b) The Government decided to extend the benefit of the "amnesty" circulars till 30-9-1986 in cases where the assessee wants to disclose income or wealth relating to the assessment years 1986-87 or earlier assessment years. This was done on account of numerous requests from various parts of the country for extending the time limit.
