- (b) whether the said plan is pending with Planning Commission;
- (c) if so, since when and the reasons for the delay;
- (d) whether any headway has been made in this regard recently; and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) what is the present position of the plan and by when it is likely to get clearance?

THE MINISTER OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRIB. SHANKA-RANA ND) (a) to (e) The Government of West Bengal submitted the Project Report on Subarnarekha barrage Project to Central Water 1981 for techno-Commission in economic clearance and acceptance by the Planning Commission. The examination technical of project has been completed but the clearance is held up for want of details from the State Government on their plans for effective and permanent protection to the command area from the flood spills of the Subarnarekha river.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI DALBIR SINGH): (a) Statewise details of towns brought under the purview of the Scheme of Integrated Development of Small and Medium Towns since the inception of the Scheme in 1979-80 till the end of 6th Plan is given at Annexe. (b) and (c) It is envisaged to bring 102 more towns under the purview of the Scheme during the 7th Plan period. 55 towns have so far been sanctioned, as per details given in Annexe. [See Appendix CXXXIX, Annexure No. 70]
