Black-marketing in Railway Tickets

Will the Minister of TRANSPORT be pleased to state;

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news item published in "The Statesman" of 9th July, 1986 under the caption "And now they beat the Computer";

(b) if so, what are the details thereof;

(c) whether Government have made any investigation as to the modus operandi of these touts and how Railway tickets are available with them when these are not available at the countries; and

(d) if so, what are the steps being taken to prevent blackmarketing in railway tickets?

THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT (SHRIMATI MOHSINA KIDWAI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The report alleged that touts are operating in the Railways Computerised Reservation Centre at New Delhi.

(c) and (d) Yes, Sir. An enquiry revealed that no confirmed ticket in the name of the companion of the reporter had been issued from any of the counters on 8.7.86 as alleged, as the waiting list for the train had started on 28.6.86 itself after which no confirmed ticket can be issued by the Computer.

Rajkot-Ahmedabad Inter-city train

1423. SHRI CHIMANBHAI MEHTA: Will the Minister of TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Rajkot-Ahmedabad inter-city train service is scheduled to commence from October next;

(b) if so, what is the estimated time to be taken by the inter-city train to shuttle between Rajkot to Ahmedabad and vice versa;

(c) what is going to be the estimated accommodation in II Class, I Class and A/C, Chair-Cars; and

(d) what is going to be the fare for different classes for journeys between Rajkot and Ahmedabad?

THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT (SHRIMATI MOHSINA KIDWAI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Approximately 4 hours and 30 minutes.

(c) It is proposed to have 2 first class and 11 second class coaches and 2 second class cum luggage vans on this train.

(d) Fare charged will be according to the normal tariff rates.
