THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT  
(SHRIMATI MOHSINA KIDWAI):

(a) No, Sir.

(b) and (c) The Zonal Railways concerned are being asked to improve the standard of maintenance. Replacements will be considered on age-cum-condition basis.

### I.C.D.S. Projects

†\*296. SHRI PAWAN KUMAR BANSAL: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) what is the total number of ICDS projects and the estimated coverage of beneficiaries in Punjab;

(b) the number of such project started this year and what was the cost involved; and

(c) whether the entire State is likely to be covered during the current Five-Year Plan period?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS AND WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI MARGARET ALVA):

(a) 34 ICDS projects had been sanctioned in Punjab till 1985-86. As per monthly progress reports for June 1986, received 32 projects. Supplementary Nutrition was being provided to 1.31 lakh children and 0.30 lakh pregnant women and nursing mother and pre-school education was being imparted to 0.96 lakh children. For 1986-87, nine projects have been sanctioned in Punjab, bringing the progressive total to 43.

(b) The expenditure on each ICDS project varies depending upon factors like the population of the project area, number of villages, pay-scales of employees in the State Government, progress of implementation etc. The estimated requirement of 9 new projects during 1986-87 is Rs. 21.17 lakhs, excluding the cost of supplementary nutrition which is met by the State Government and the cost of training.

(c) It will not be possible to achieve full coverage of Punjab State by ICDS by 1989-90.

### New train between Bombay and Kerala

\*297. SHRI T. K. C. VADUTHALA: Will the Minister of TRANSPORT be pleased to state whether one more train from Bombay to Kerala is likely to be introduced for the convenience of the large number of Keralites living in Bombay and the neighbouring cities who mainly depend upon the railways for their journeys?

THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT (SHRIMATI MOHSINA KIDWAI): In view of constraints of line capacity and acute shortage of coaches, it is not feasible to introduce a new train. However, special trains are run during the summer season to provide relief.
