इन सब पर प्राइस डिपेंड करता है और जहाँ तक फारमर का सवाल है हम उनकी मदद करते हैं जब स्टेट गवर्नमेंट रिक्वेस्ट करती है। Government of India intervenes in the market, purchases at the fixed prices and shares the losses with the State. At present, except in Mizoram, Central Government approval has not been sought for market intervention so far as ginger is concerned.

#### Development of towns in Tamil Nadu and Kerala

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state :

(a) the towns/cities in Tamil

Nadu and Kerala which were given financial assistance under the Central scheme during the Sixth Five Year Plan period for urban improvements ;

(b) the amounts sanctioned and spent during the period in each case ; and

(c) the towns and cities in the two states selected for urban improvements by the Central Government during the Seventh Five Year Plan period and also the money budgeted for in each case ?

**THE MINISTER OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ABDUL GHAFOOR) :** (a) and (b) Statement is laid on the Table of the Sabha.

(c) One town in Tamil Nadu, viz., Pudukottai, and three towns in Kerala, viz. Palghat, Thodupuzha and Manjeri, have been selected so far under the scheme during the 7th Plan Period.

Each town is eligible for a maximum assistance of Rs. 52 lakhs inclusive of a compulsory component of Rs. 6.00 lakhs for low cost sanitation works, on matching basis. Additional assistance of Rs. 8 lakhs for low cost sanitation works will also be available on matching basis, if opted for.
