THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COOPERATION (SHRI YOGENDRA MAK WANA): (a) Yes Sir. A High Security Animal Disease Laboratory of the Indian Veterinary Research Institute (IVRI) is to be set up at Bhopal and the Government of Madhya Pradesh have made available 134.89 acres of land for the same.

- (b) The Laboratory is being established with the assistance of United Nations Development Programme. Considerable ground work had to be done before the proposal could be cleared at different governmental levels.
- (c) The Government of India input worth Rs. 100 lakhs has been included in the EFC Memo of 7th Plan of the IVRI which is under consideration of the Government.
