THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE INDUSTRIAL DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M. ARUNA-CHALAM): The loss suffered by industries depends on several factors such as nonavailability of raw material, labour problem,, shortage of capital and shortage of power etc. It is, therefore, difficult to quantify loss suffered by the industries because of shortage of power alone. However, the Central Electricity Authority (CEA) had entrusted National Council of Applied Economic Research (NCEAR) a study on the impact of power shortage in agriculture and industry. Based on the study, two statements showing Statewise and Industry-wise loss of production due to power shortage during 1982-83 and 1983-84 at 1979-80 prices are enclosed. ASee below).
