(b) and (c) The Government had appointed a Working Group on Re-organisation of Family Welfare and Primary Health Care services in urban areas. The working group has recommended establishment of Health Units which would provide integrated services in promotional, preventive and curative aspects with priority attention to slum areas or areas inhabited by underprevileged sections of the society. The Government of India have accepted these recommendations. These units are being established in a phased manner.

878 Health posts and 14 city Family Welfare Bureau as on 31-7-86 covering 127 cities in 10 States and 2 UTs have been sanctioned. No sruvey to study health conditions of weaker sections in areas has been conducted. However, to provide better health services to tribal and hilly population, the norms of establishof primary health centres and sub-centres has been relaxed from 30,000 to 20,000 population and from 5,000 to 3,000 population respectively.

Passengers Kacheguda/Secunderabad coming from side on the metre gauge can travel towards Bombay and Northern India with a change. over at Manmad where convenient connections are available and suitable quota of reservation is provided.

(c) Two pairs of fast trains viz. 551/552 Ajanata Express and 653/564 Kacheguda-Manmad Fast Passenger run between. Kacheguda and Manmad. One first class coach runs on 551/552 Ajanta Express. while one composite first-cum-second class coach runs on 563/564 Fast passenger. No A/C sleeper coach is attached to these trains.
