

Influx of foreigners from Bangladesh via Murshidabad and Malda districts

2148. SHRI PARVATHANENI UPENDRA: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that influx of foreigners from Bangladesh into India through the district of Murshidabad and Malda is continuing unabated; and

(b) if so, the measures being taken by Government to prevent such infiltration of people from Bangladesh?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERNAL SECURITY (SHRI ARUN NEHRU): (a) No, Sir.

Assam Chief Minister's suggestion for amending illegal Migrants (Determination by Tribunals) Act

2149. SHRI PARVATHANENI UPENDRA: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have received any suggestions from the Chief Minister of Assam for making amendments to the Illegal Migrants (Determination by Tribunals) Act:

(c) what decision has been taken by the Central Government in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF STATES (SHRI GHULAM NABI AZAD): (a) and (b) The State Government of Assam have submitted a proposal to amend the Illegal Migrants (Determination by Tribunals) Act, 1983, suggesting, *inter alia*:

(i) that, each Tribunal should have only one member as against three members at present:

(ii) that, in case of private complaints the provisions (a) requiring the applicant to be residing within 3 KMs from the place of residence

of the person in relation to whom the application for being declared an illegal migrant is made, and

(b) requiring payment of fee of Rs. 25/- with every complaint, should be deleted; and

(iii) that, in case where a question arises whether a person is an illegal migrant or not the burden of proof should lie on such person.

(c) The proposal is under consideration.
