Various Government Departments and Public Undertakings have been instructed to fully implement the policy of reservation so as to ensure proper representation of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.

The inadequate representation of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in services was brought to notice of the Government by the Commission for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes. The recommendations made by the Commission in this regard have been examined and suitable action taken.
