### Fertilizer Production

85. SHRI D. B. CHANDRA GOWDA: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state;

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to a news item which appeared in the *Economic Times* on 20th June, 1986 under the caption "Fertiliser production below installed capacity";

(b) if so, the quantum of fertilisers produced by each of the fertiliser units in the public sector during the last three years;

(c) whether it is a fact that the farmers are not getting the fertilisers at a reasonable price due to shortage; and

(d) if so, what steps are being taken by Government to boost the production of fertilisers in the country and also to make these available at a reasonable price?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF FERTILIZERS (SHRI K. NATWAR SINGH): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) A statement containing the requisite details is attached (*See below*).

(c) No, Sir. Fertilizer availability in almost all parts of the country is more than satisfactory.

(d) A major programme has been undertaken to increase the production of fertilizers in the country during the Seventh Plan period. As a part of this programme, 15 fertilizer projects, including expansion schemes, have been taken on hand, to add substantially to the fertilizer capacity already under operation. Efforts are also being made to optimise production in the existing fertilizer plants by modernising them and also by providing captive power units.

It is the policy of the Government to make fertilizers available to the farmers at stable and reasonable prices. To ensure this, Government exercises statutory control over selling prices, which are kept at a reasonable level through Government subsidy. The dealers cannot charge, under the law, a price higher than the statutory selling price fixed by the Government. The State Governments are empowered to take legal action against the defaulting dealers, if any, under the Essential Commodities Act.

#### **Gas leakage in Captive Power Station at Rourkela Steel Plant**

Will the Minister of STEEL AND MINES be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a worker was killed and several others were injured following a gas leakage from an old captive power station at the Rourkela Steel Plant in the third week of June, 1986; and

(b) if so, what are the details thereof, stating the results of the inquiry, if any made by Government into the mishap and the action taken in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI K. C. PANT); (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. On June 17, 1986, one employee of Steel Authority of India Limited died and 8 other persons (two employees of SAIL and six contract workers) were affected. 3-s a. Ksalt af aa mdd/yy, ia the old captive power plant of Rourkela Steel Plant in what may liav, been a case of gas leakage.

The Inspector of Factories has conducted statutory investigations under the Indian Factories Act, 1948, and his findings about the incident are awaited.

The Fatal Accident Investigation and Enquiry Committee of the Plant has ais\* enquired into the incident and their report is also awaited.
