THE MINISTER OF TOURISM (SHRI MUFTI MOHD. SYED): (a) The Plan funds allocation of the Department of Tourism for the current financial year 1986-87 is Rs. 26.30 crores. It may be stated the allocation of funds is not made on Statewise basis, but on the basis of projects under schemes identified by the Department of Tourism for development of tourism throughout the country, such as, Cultural Tourism, Sports Tourism Travel Circuit, Wildlife Tourism, Yatri Niwas, Yatrikas, etc., subject to availability of funds and inter-se priorities.
