(b) Planning Commission have cleared in March, 4986 Part I of the project envisaging provision of a single line from Dum Dum to Prinsep Ghat with diesel haulage at an estimated cost of Rs. 35 crores. By January, 1985, in stages, 10 km single line section with diesel haulage from Prinsep Ghat was commissioned. Further work j_s in progress.

Upto 31-3-1986 approximate expenditure on this project has been Rs. 14.40 crores. For 1986-87 a sum of Rs. 3.0 crores ha_s been earmarked.
