

### Target of tree plantation

981. SHRI VITHALRAO MADHAV-

SHRI RAM CHANDRA VIKAL:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) what is the total area of land where afforestation has been done during the current year;

(b) whether the target fixed in this regard has been achieved; and

(c) what special measures have been taken to retain the ecological balance by creating new forests in deforested areas?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS: (SHRI Z. R. ANSARI):

(a) and (b) The planting operations in most of the States/Union Territories for 1986-87 have just begun and are continuing. Hence it is not possible to indicate achievements of afforestation for the total year of 1986-87. However, as per available reports up to June, 1986, 1430 lakh seedlings have been planted i.e. approximately 79,500 ha.

(c) The Action Plan for promoting afforestation and wastelands development has already been communicated to all the State/Union Territory Governments for further follow up action. A copy of the Action Plan is enclosed. (See Appendix CXXXIX, Annexure No. 55].

### Arrival of super computers in the country
