THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (DR. SHAKEEL AHMAD): (a) and (b) As per Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI)'s Telecommunications Traffic Order 1999 as amended from time to time, the telephone tariff is under forbearance except tariff applicable for fixed line rural subscribers, roaming services in mobile telephony and for leased circuit.

(c) and (d) The ADC is being regulated by TRAI by issuing Interconnect Usage Charges (IUC) Regulations from time to time. TRAI has issued latest regulation on 21.3.2007.

Delay in implementation of 3 G spectrum policy

(a) whether it is a fact that Government have not implemented the 3 G spectrum policy, timely;

(b) if so, the reasons for failure in its timely implementation;

(c) whether Government are going to take any step regarding implementation of this policy without any further delay;

(d) if so, what and by when; and

(e) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (DR. SHAKEEL AHMAD): (a) to (e) The guidelines for implementation of 3G systems are under formulation taking into account the recommendations of Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) and other related aspects, including availability/vacation of spectrum from other existing users like defence, system costs, international practices and experiences, etc. so as to meet our national objectives. Incidentally, the 3G systems are yet to be implemented in large number of countries. .
