

would be explained by the officers to the people. We have been also calling meetings of some of the representatives of the people and if they find any difficulty definitely we will explain to them.

I have noted all other points raised and I am thankful to hon. Members for their valuable contributions and also for their co-operation. Thank you.

THE VICE-CHAIRMAN (SHRI PAWAN KUMAR BANSAL): I shall first put the motion regarding The Appropriation Bill, 1986 to vote. The question is:

That the Bill to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of India for the services of the financial year 1985-86, as passed by the Lok Sabha, be taken into consideration.

The motion was adopted.

THE VICE-CHAIRMAN (SHRI PAWAN KUMAR BANSAL): We shall now take up clause-by-clause consideration of the Bill.

Clause 2 and 3 and the Schedule were added to the Bill.

Clause 1, the Enacting Formula and the Title were added to the Bill.

SHRI JANARDHAN POOJARI: Sir, I move:

"That the Bill be returned."

The question was put and the motion was adopted.

THE VICE-CHAIRMAN (SHRI PAWAN KUMAR BANSAL): The question is:

That the Bill to provide for the authorisation of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of India to meet the amounts spent

on certain services during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1984 in excess of the amount granted for those services and for that year, as passed by the Lok Sabha, be taken into consideration.

The motion was adopted.

THE VICE-CHAIRMAN (SHRI PAWAN KUMAR BANSAL): Now we shall take up clause-by-clause consideration of the Bill.

Clause 2 and 3 and the Schedule were added to the Bill.

Clause 1, the Enacting Formula and the Title were added to the Bill.

SHRI JANARDHAN POOJARI: Sir, I move:

"That the bill be returned."

The question was put and the motion was adopted.
