were interviewed bv Selection Committee under the Chairmanship Shri P. N. Haksar with Prof. Randhir Singh of Delhi University, Prof. Yoginder Singh of Jawaharlal University Director Nehru the and Nehru Memorial Museum and library as members. The committee recommended 10 candidates for the above fellowships. In addition, the Committee considered 18 applicants for senior fellowships in the range Rs. 2000/- 2500 and rcommended 5 candidates after going through record, academic research experience etc. The constitution of the Committee was approved by the Vice-Chairman of the Executive Council Nehru Memorial Museum and Library- Society.

- (e) As per provisions, of the Fellowship scheme the Selection Committee, on the basis of his scholary imminence and other academic research credentials, also recommended Gopal for the award of Senior Fellowship.
