

were interviewed by a Selection Committee under the Chairmanship of Shri P. N. Haksar with Prof. Randhir Singh of Delhi University, Prof. Yoginder Singh of Jawaharlal Nehru University and the Director Nehru Memorial Museum and Library as members. The committee recommended 10 candidates for the above fellowships. In addition, the Committee considered 18 applicants for senior fellowships in the range of Rs. 2000/- 2500 and recommended 5 candidates after going through their academic record, research experience etc. The constitution of the Committee was approved by the Vice-Chairman of the Executive Council Nehru Memorial Museum and Library Society.

(e) As per provisions of the Fellowship scheme the Selection Committee, on the basis of his scholarly eminence and other academic research credentials, also recommended Dr. S. Gopal for the award of Senior Fellowship.

(f) Since no complaint has been received by Nehru Memorial Museum and Library and the Department of Culture, no action has been taken.

Restrictions on the sale of platform tickets

1099. SHRI DHULESHWAR MENA: Will the Minister of TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether any assessment has been made about the outcome of the recent restriction on the sale of platform tickets at Delhi, New Delhi and Hazrat-Nizamuddin stations during peak hours from 6.00 to 8.00 A. M. and 4.00 to 6.00 P. M., if so, what are the details thereof;

(b) the total loss of revenue daily from the sale of platform tickets as a sequel to such restrictions;

(c) whether these restrictions are likely to be made a permanent feature; and

(d) if so, what are the arrangements made for proper guidance of unaccompanied passengers particularly ladies and physically handicapped to locate their reservations to get the services of porters and lot of other problems being faced during peak hours at the arrival and departure of long-distance trains?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MADHAVRAO SCINDIA): (a) Yes, Sir. Although, there was appreciable reduction in the congestion on the platforms during the period 1-2-1986 to 10.2.86 when the experiment was carried out, the public did not like such a restriction.

(b) The earning from sale of platform tickets during this 10 day period was less by Rs. 5160 as compared to the corresponding 10 day period of last year.

(c) No, Sir.

(d) Does not arise. The experiment was tried out for only 10 days.
