(b) whether it is also a fact that out of the target of opening 220 new Post Offices only six were opened in 1984-85; and

(c) if so, what are the reasons thereof?

THE MINISTHR OF STATFI OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI RAM NIWAS MIRDHA): (a) A

target of 198 new post oflices (including 50 in yackwaritllribal areas was set for Bihar Circle under Annual Plan 1885-86. However, implementa the tion of the 'tar-get was subject to with drawal of central government ban on creation of posts. As the ban con tinues to be in force, no new post offices have been sanctioned in Bihar in other Circles)^ during the (or **י**∧י current year.

. (b) Under Annual Plan 1984-85, a target of 220 new post offices was set for Bihar Circle. The programme was not implemented on account of the ban on creation of posts. However, 6 rural post . offices were opened in the Circle during 1984-85 on the basis of a special approval obtained from the Ministry of Finance.

(c) The reasons are contained in replies to parts (a) and (b) above.

Telephone service in village Koriahi of Bihar

One Long Distance Public Telephone facility has been provided in village Konthi, block Sutsund of Silamarhi District of Bihar for public convenience in a grocei's shop. Second public telephone in the sams hexagonal area in the Post Office or elsewhere is not permissible.'

It is still to be approved by the Board of Direc tors of Indian Telephone Industries Limited.

(b) It is proposed to make available about 11 lakh telephone connections during the Seventh Five Year Plan period.
