

Combination of drugs

†2351. SHRIMATI MONIKA DAS : Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) the names of the combinations of the drugs which have been introduced in our country during the last three years alongwith the composition of each;

(b) the names of the preparations about which Government received reports about irrational combination of drugs; and

(c) what is the procedure being adopted by Government for the withdrawal of irrational combination of drugs; and

(d) the names of the combination of marketing in the country by the drug Authorities during the last three years, alongwith the details of drugs and the state authority which cleared the particular combination?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI S. KRISHNA KUMAR): (a) and (b) The information is being collected from the State Drug Control authorities and will be laid on the table of the Sabha.

(b) This Ministry has not received any such report about irrationality of combination of drugs.

(c) The proposals for withdrawal of irrational drug combinations are reviewed by the Drugs Technical Advisory Board (DTAB) which is a statutory body under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act to advise the Government on all technical matters. Necessary action to ban the manufacture and sale of irrational drug formulations is taken by the Government based on the recommendations made by the D.T.A.B.

संघ राज्य क्षेत्र दिल्ली के क्षय रोगियों का औसत

2353. श्री सत्य प्रकाश मालवीय : क्या स्वास्थ्य और परिवार कल्याण मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि :

(क) राष्ट्रीय औसत की तुलना में दिल्ली में क्षय रोगियों की संख्या का अनुपात कितना है ;

(ख) क्षयरोगियों का प्रति हजार राष्ट्रीय औसत कितना है और संघ राज्य क्षेत्र दिल्ली में यह संख्या प्रति हजार कितनी है ; और

(ग) संघ राज्य क्षेत्र दिल्ली में इस बढ़ती बीमारी को रोकने के लिए सरकार ने क्या कदम उठाये हैं ?

परिवार कल्याण विभाग में उप-मंत्री (श्री एस० कृष्ण कुमार) : (क) और (ख) 1955-58 के दौरान किये गये राष्ट्रीय नमूना क्षय रोग सर्वेक्षण तथा बाद के वर्षों के किये गये संमित सर्वेक्षणों के परिणाम के अनुसार अनुमान है कि दिल्ली में क्षय रोग की व्यापकता दर लगभग राष्ट्रीय औसत दर के बराबर ही है ।

अनुमान है कि प्रति हजार लगभग 1.5 व्यक्ति (अर्थात् जनसंख्या का 1.5 प्रतिशत) ऐसे हैं जो फेफड़े के क्षय रोग से पीड़ित हैं और उनका यह रोग एक्स-रे के हिसाब से सक्रिय है । इनमें से 1/4

लोगों का थूक पार्जिटिव है अथवा वे संक्रामक हैं।

(ग) दिल्ली में क्षय रोग की समस्या से निपटने के लिए विभिन्न एजेंसियों द्वारा संचालित 13 क्षय रोग केन्द्र/क्षय रोग कलनिक क्षय रोगियों का पता लगाने तथा क्षय रोग से पीड़ित व्यक्तियों को घर पर उपचार उपलब्ध करने का कार्य कर रहे हैं, गर्भार रूप से पीड़ित क्षय रोगियों के इलाज के लिए दिल्ली स्थित विभिन्न संस्थाओं में 1500 से अधिक पलंग हैं, दिल्ली स्थित क्षय रोग क्लिनिकों को एक केन्द्र प्रायोजित योजना के रूप में क्षय रोग रोगी औषधियाँ/सामग्री और उपकरण सप्लाई किये जाते हैं, जिन लोगों को यह रोग होने का खतरा होता है, उन्हें रोग प्रतिरक्षण के विस्तारित कार्यक्रम के एक अंग के रूप में बी० सी० जी० वैक्सीनेशन सुविधाएँ उपलब्ध की जाती है।

However, assistance is given by Delhi Administration to 2 Unani Colleges. The information available is given in the enclosed statement I. (See below)

(d) The Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine which is an autonomous Body and fully funded by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare conducts research in 6 Unani institutions as per details given in the Statement II.
