Similar information as per UGC guidelines, in respect of the posts of I ecrurers in Library Science in the universities r.nd for the posts of Librarians, etc., in the academic libraries is given in d statements II and HI, respectively. It would be seen therefrom that the pay-scales for the posts of Librarians, etc., in the Ministry's libraries are different from rs in the universities and librarians in the academic libraries.
