CHINDAMBARAM): (a) and (b) The scheme of the Civil Services Examination consisting of Preliminary Examination and the Main Examination (Written and interview) for rectruitment to t'ne Servics, Indian Administrative Indian Foreign Service, Indian Police Service and various non-technical Central ServicesjPosts Group 'A' and Group 'B' was introduced in the year 1979. This was based on the recommendations of ths Committee on Recruitment Policy andl Sslection Methods under the Chairmanship of Dr. D. S. Kothari set up by the Union Public Service Commission and recommendations of the Commission thereon as accepted by the Government. Committee had This recommended periodic review of the standards of recruitment. Also the Estimates Committee (1983-84) of the 7th Lok Sabha in their 77th report recommended that as by examinations had been then five held under the revised pattern, the new svsteili of the Civil Services Examination should be reviewed. The Government is examining various proposals to introduce changes in the method of recruitment to the All India and Group 'A' Services and in the induction-training of the selected officers. Since no final decisions have been taken, it would not be possible to give details.
