- (d) The following steps have been taken by the Delhi Administration to control the situaition and to punish the drug traffickers:—
- 1. Intelligence system strengthened for detecting persons who indulge in drug trafficking.
- 2. Patrolling has been intensified in vulnerable areas known for drug trafficking and drug using.
- 3. Continuous efforts are being made by both the local police as well as crime branch to conduct raids and apprehend drug pedlars.
- 4. Surprise checking of vehicles is being organised to detect transportation of narcotics and psychotropic substances.

## Menace of dacoity in the dacoity Prone areas of Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan

1949. SHRI J.K. JAIN: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any working group was constituted by the Planning Commission for exploring means and resources to fight the menance of dacoity in the dacoity-prone areas of Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan;
- (b) whether the said working group has made any survey in this reagrd;
- (c) which were the areas in the above States which were surveyed;
- (d) whether the working group has made any recommendations in the matter for the Seventh Five Year Plan period; and
  - (c) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING (SHRI AJIT KUMAR PANJA):

- (a) A working Group was set up by the Planning Commission in June, 1983, the terms of reference of which included formulation of a Special Area Plan for the dacoity-prone districts of U.P., M.P. and Rajasthan and setting out a longterm socioeconomic strategy for combating the dacoity problem.
  - (b) No, Sir.
  - (c) Does not arise.
- (d) and (e) The Working Group has recommended taking up of developmental programmes in three sectors, namely, Ravine Reclamation, Road/Bridge Construction and Rural Electrification. The Programme recommended involves an outlay of Rs. 641.86 crores. Sectorwise break-up of this amount is given below:—
