THE MINISTER OF ENERGY (SHRI VASANT SATHE): (a) and (b) Technical co-operation between India and USSR has been in existence even prior to the identification of the 15 projects for long term co-operation upto 2000 A.D. The 15 coal projects referred to in the question 929 replied on 25-11-1985 were identified by the Indo-Soviet Working Group on Coal in the meeting held in Moscow in October, November, 1985 for continuing long term co-operation.
