Technical collaboration with the Soviet Union

2140. SHRI ADINARAYANA REDDY Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to refer to the answer to Unstarred Question 929 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 25th November, 1985 and state:

(a) whether Government already had some technical collaboration with the Soviet Union in the field of coal; and

(b) if so, the names of the projects and their locations?

THE MINISTER OF ENERGY (SHRI VASANT SATHE): (a) and (b) Technical co-operation between India and USSR has been in existence even prior to the identification of the 15 projects for long term co-operation upto 2000 A.D. The 15 coal projects referred to in the question 929 replied on 25-11-1985 were identified by the Indo-Soviet Working Group on Coal in the meeting held in Moscow in October, November, 1985 for continuing long term co-operation.

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI RAM NIWAS MIRDHA): Total value of losses suffered by Telephone Department due to recent rains and floods in Tamil Nadu Circle is about 1 crore and 10 lakhs and the expenditure incurred for repairs and restoration of telecommunication system there is about Rs. 74.81 lakhs, including Madras city.

(a) whether it is a fact that a group of Soda Ash manufacturers and consumers of Soda Ash met on 31st August, 1985

(c) if so, what are the details thereof; and

(d) to what extent Government have accepted the recommendations of the Group?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CHEMICALS AND PETRO CHEMICALS (SHRI R. K. JAICHANDRA SINGH): (a) to (d) A meeting of the Sub-Committee on Monitoring of supplies of Soda Ash was held on 30.8.1985 to review the implementation of the guidelines on distribution of Soda Ash by the manufacturers to various consumers. These guidelines were issued by Government on 18.7.1985. This Sub-Committee includes representatives of both manufacturers and consumers besides Government Officials and meets from time to time to review the distribution of Soda Ash.
