

NTPC were discontinued on 17th and 18th Nov., 1985 and the three units of that Station were shut-down,

Government directed immediate resumption of coal supplies. The generating units are now functioning. According to the NTPC the loss in generation was 42.29 MU.

The matters regarding weighment of coal has been reviewed and it has been decided that, over the next five weeks, weighments on the belt weigher, after calibration, should be compared with the weighment on the mechanical weigher, so that the exact discrepancy can be worked out and resolved.

#### Conveyance charges to SMOs/MOs

Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to refer to the answer to Unstarred Question 1986 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 14th August, 1985 regarding conveyance allowance to officers in DESU and state:

(a) whether the Senior Medical Officers/Medical Officers of Delhi Electric-Supply Undertaking are not being given fixed conveyance allowance because their duties do not involve more extensive travelling than Administrative Officers;

(b) whether the travelling of these two categories of officers for performing official journeys was compared in terms of distance covered by them;

(c) if so, which category has to cover more distance in this regard;

(d) whether it is also a fact that the actual conveyance higher charges spent by SMOs/MOs are not being reimbursed to them;

(e) whether it is also a fact that the MOs/SMOs are asked by Chief Medical Officer to travel by bus while returning after attending to their official duties; and

(f) if the reply to parts (d) and (e) above be in the affirmative the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POWER (SHRI ARIF MOHD. KHAN), (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) any (c) Since the duties of two categories of Officers are different, comparison is not valid.

(d) to (f) SMOs/MOs are reimbursed actual conveyance charges by three-wheeler scooter, for to and from journey, in connection with the official duties within a radius of 8 kms. In case, the journey is performed beyond 8 kms, mileage allowance, as per rules is given. In the exigencies of work, the amount spent on hiring three-wheeler scooter for one way journey or in certain cases both way journeys beyond 8 kms. may also be reimbursed, restricting the total amount of expenditure on hiring any mode of conveyance including three wheeler scooter as per rules.

#### **Residuary jurisdiction of Western Coalfield Limited**

SHRI ASHWANI KUMAR:

Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to refer to the answer to Starred Question 1)5 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 25th November, 1955 and state:

(a) what will be the residuary jurisdiction and the area covered by Western Coalfields Limited having office at Nagpur;

(b) which area will be covered by the two new companies. Northern Coalfields Limited having Headquarters at Sinrauli (M.P.) and South-Eastern Coalfields Limited with headquarters at Bilaspur (M.P.):

(c) how many existing mines will be covered by these three companies; and

(d) what is the future programme of development of opening new mines under the area covered by Western Coalfields Limited?

THE MINISTER OF ENERGY (SHRI VASANT SATHE); (a) and (b) These Jurisdictions are yet to be exactly delineated.

(c) Over 120 existing mines will be covered by these three companies.

(d) During the Seventh Plan period Western Coalfields Limited will have an investment of about Rs. 600 crores to attain a production level of 24.5 million tonnes by 1989-90.

#### **Thermal power station Chandrapur**

2167. MISS SAROJ KHAPARDE. Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Maharashtra Government have urged the Central Government for setting up of a Super Thermal Power Station in Chandrapur area based on Coal availability from the Wardha Valley Coal Fields;

(b) if so, the details of the scheme; and

If yes, when the project is proposed to be cleared?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POWER (SHRI ARIF MOHD. KHAN): (a) to (b) On the availability of coal from Wardha coal fields, a total capacity of 1820 MW has already been approved for implementation in the State sector at Chandrapur the State Government had also proposed installation of a Super Thermal Power Station in the Central Sector. An investment decision for implementation of the Central project can be taken only after all the inputs such as Coal, environmental clearance, and financial resources, etc. have been tied up and the techno-economic viability of the project, in addition to the capacity already approved, is established.
