Government Health Scheme beneficiaries and drawing basic pay of Rs. 1600/- p.m. and above are entitled to avail of this facility directly and those officers drawing less than Rs. 1600/- basic pay and members of their family can avail of this facility on the recommendation of Authorised Medical Attendant of the concerned Central Government Health Scheme dispensary.
