THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS AND WOMEN'S WELFARE (SMT. MARGARET ALVA): (a) With a view to promoting sports activities in the country, the Government adopted a Resolution on National Sports Policy which was laid on the Table of the Sabha on the 21st August, 1984 and is implementing various schemes like grants to State Sports Councils, Grants to national sports federations, National Coaching Scheme, Sports Talent Search Scholarships, All India Rural Sports Tournaments, National Sports Championships for women, Sports Talent Search Contest, etc. The Government also proposes to implement some new schemes like Setting up of Sports Hostels, Adoption of Schools for Sports, etc.

(b) An allocation of Rs. 200 crores has been proposed.

(d) The Indian Olympic Association which holds the National Games proposes to hold the games once in every two years.
