Plan outlay for Madhya Pradesh for 1985-86

2533. SHRIMATI MAIMOONA SULTAN : Will PRIME the MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) the annual plan outlay for 1985-86 for Madhya Pradesh as proposed by the State Government indicating the sector-wise and servicewise breakup thereof; and

(b) the sectorwise/service plan outlays as approved by the Planning Commission and the Central Government and the extent to which respective targets are expected to be slashed as a result of there cuts?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING (SHRI AJIT PANJA): (a) and (b) A statement showing headwise outlays proposed by the State Government and as approved by Planning Commission for the Annual Plan 1985-86 of Madhya Pradesh is enclosed. The outlays as approved are not less than the proposed outlays under any of the Heads of Development. Rather, approved outlays exceed the proposed outlay under a number of beads of development. As such the question of slashing the targets does not arise.

It may also be pointed out that formulation of proposals by the State Government is only the first step in the exercise for formulating the State Plans. These proposals are discussed in detail in the Planning Commission with the representatives of the respective State Governments and plans are finalised, keeping in view the available resources. As far as possible, agreed decisions are taken with regard to overall size of the plans, sectoral outlays and targets.
