THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI BAM NIWAS MIRDM Abouk 590 temporary telephone connections have been provided in 1985 in Madras Telephone System. Out of which, 5H were provided from Kodambakkam Telephone Exchange.

- (b) Y<3, Sir. A temporary telephone connection is enerally provided for 'six months initially and can be extended, thereafter depending upon the need and exchange loading position.
- (c) 29 temporary telephone connections have been extended for more than six memths in Kodai , Telephone Exchange.

New petro-chemical complexes both for aromatics as well as olefins are propos ed to be set up. It has been decided to permit new grass-root units only of eco nomically viable sizes and the existing units will be permitted to expand to eco nomic viable sizes if they so desire. This policy is expected to augment production, increase product u bring about competitiveness in petrochemical industry. The development efforts will cover basic raw material, intermediates and downstream units in the field of synthetic fibre, plastics, synthetic rubber and detergent, etc.
