Production of drugs

2826. SHRI PRAVIN KUMAR PRAJAPATI: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether Cloxacillin, Cephalordine, Framycetine, Oxacillin, Gentamycin, Neomycin, Kanamycin, Doxycycline, Lyme-cycline, Erthromycin, Carbencillin, Ampicillin and Amoxicillin are being imported or indigenously produced;

(b) what was the quantity of each drug imported during the last three years year-wise along with average CIF price of each;

(c) what was the production of each drug during the last three years, year-wise incase indigenously produced long with name of each producer, licensed capacity, stage of manufacture of each drug and what was the production during the last three years;

(d) what is the price fixed for each drug by Government and what is the landed cost of import in each case;

(e) names of five major formulators of each drug and what is the price of drug taken for fixation of each formulation price along price fixed of each formulation; and

(f) names of drugs which have not been included in the delicensing list?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CHEMICALS AND PETROCHEMICALS (SHRI R. K. JAICHANDRA SINGH): (a) To the extent information is available, the entire requirements of Cloxacillin, Cephalordine, Oxacillin Lyme-cycline, Neomycin, Carbencillin are being met wholly by imports. The requirement of other bulk drugs referred to in the question are being met through imports as well as indigenous production,

(b) Details of imports are published in the Monthly Statistics for Foreign Trade in India Vol. II, copies of which are available in the Parliament Library.

(c) Details of production of bulk drugs which are monitored by this Ministry along with other details to the extent information is available, are given in the attached statement.

(d) Prices notified by the Govt. under DPCO are published in the Official Gazette copies of which are available in Parliament Library. The landed cost varies from consignment to consignment and the prevailing custom duty.

(e) Sales of formulations by individual companies are not monitored. Details of prices fixed by Govt. are published in the Official Gazette notification, copies of which are available in Parliament Library. The prices of formulations are based on the notified price of the bulk drug, where-over the price is notified, and in other cases on the landed cost.

(f) Cloxacillin, Framycetine, Oxacillin, Gentamycin, Kanamycin, Lyme-cycline, Garbenicillin, Amoxicillin have not been included in the delicensing list.

(d) names of drug which fall under price exempted category produced by each of these companies along with licensed capacity and production during the last three years, yearwise ;

(e) names of formulations based on these drugs along with selling price of each during 1979 and 1985; and

(f) names of drugs where production exceeded than the permitted capacity which falls under category III and IV of these companies?
